weaver-of-fictions was originally written as a solo recorder study for Genevieve Lacey and later incorporated as the prelude to *The Navigator*. The title is a reference to one of the descriptive names given to the Ancient Greek divinity Eros and comes from a line in Scene 2 of the opera libretto by Patricia Sykes.

A version of weaver-of-fictions was premiered by Genevieve Lacey in Brisbane on February 4 2007 at Daryl Buckley's 50th birthday party. The first concert performance of this score of weaver-of-fictions was given by Genevieve Lacey on May 26 2007 at the Iwaki Auditorium in Melbourne.

The title *the long forgetting...* comes from a line in Scene 6 of *The Navigator* libretto by Patricia Sykes. This solo was written as part of the activities of a DAAD Artist-in-residence programme in Berlin.
