Strings: violin I, violin II, viola, cello, double bass.

Dynamic markings: *mf*, *f*, *mp*, *pp*, *p*, *sim.*

Performance instructions: (regular timpani mallets) place large Japanese temple bowl on timpani, always let ring, (bowed), (struck), (bowed), (motor ON - SLOW), (keep down), unis. non vib. flautando.
